

Ownership structure

The Canton of Graubünden continues to hold 100% of the voting stock and an 84.6% economic interest in the bank. The government of the Canton of Graubünden supervises the bank, elects its board of directors and signs off the bank's annual financial statements.

Apart from the Canton of Graubünden, no other person or company holds more than 25% of the participating certificates.

The participation certificates of Graubündner Kantonalbank (GKB) are traded on the SIX Swiss Exchange (securities number 134020/symbol GRKP)

Market and services

The primary business field of GKB is the provision of commercial and individual banking services that support the inhabitants of the canton and the local economy (retail banking).

Cantonal law stipulates that the principal field of activity of GKB must be situated in the Canton of Graubünden. GKB has around 40 branch offices in the Canton of Graubünden. It does not have any branches or subsidiaries outside Switzerland. The bank currently has over 1'000 employees.
